HOLE 10 - LooksTough

#10 features a water fountain behind the red tee. The narrow fairway runs slightly uphill and then slopes slightly right. Large trees border its both sides. The right area of green grass sharply contrasts with the left one of brown eel grass bushes. A right exit leads to hole #1 and two left ones to holes #15 and #11 respectively. There are 3 bunkers one after another before the right blue stake; one behind the green and one that covers its right front half.

HOLE 11 - Looks Easy

Both tees are uphill and surrounded with eel grass bushes and large trees. Trees and bushes are on both sides of the fairway. There are 2 bunkers on the left: a deep one between the 150-yard blue stake and the 75-yard orange marker, and a long and shallow one before the green. The left and right bunkers guard the green that slopes back to front. A red-staked ditch runs about 10 yards behind the green.

HOLE 12 - Don't Get Wet

Water! Water! And more water. A red-staked ditch to start with is in front of the blue tee. A long green fence on the right is out of bounds. Trees and bushes are on the left. A large yellow-staked lake is also on the left just 15 yards past the blue stake and joined by another fairway-crossing one. A drop area is provided for the left lake. Two bunkers protect the well-elevated green that slopes front.

HOLE 13 – A Chip and A Putt

A yellow-staked lake crosses the fairway. A big and long bunker guards the bowl-shaped green on the left; a smaller one on the right. A red-staked ditch lurks behind the green. Bushes cover both left and right areas.

HOLE 14 - Bushes & Bunkers

#14 features bushes and bunkers. Bushes grow strong in front of both tee boxes and surround this hole. It has 6 intimidating bunkers: 1 bunker on the left and 1 bunker on the right at the 150-yard markers, twin bunkers on the left before left-and-right-bunkered green. (Photo: Dave Weston)

HOLE 15 - Brendan's Dimples

Bushes are on both sides. There are 2 left bunkers before the green, one on the right and one behind the green.

HOLE 16 - More Bushes

Bushes surround hole #16. One bunker is on the right cart path with a fan palm in the middle. A long one is on the left before the exit to #17. Another one is right after the exit. An island in the middle has 2 palm trees. 3 bunkers guard the green on the right; one on the left.

HOLE 17 - Life's A Beach

Bushes grow on both sides of the fairway. The Arabian Gulf is beyond those right bushes. One long and shallow bunker lies on the right before the 150-yard marker. A much deeper one does on the left. The green has bunkers on both sides.

HOLE 18 - Easy Finish

Formerly a par 4, hole #18 was made a par 5 in 2006. Men's tee box is situated on the beach. Ladies' tee is where men's tee used to be. Yellowed-staked area is in front of ladies' tee. A drop area is provided. Red-staked hazards are on both sides of the fairway. The driving range on the right of the green and the clubhouse behind it are designated as out of bounds. Big and deep bunkers are on the left and right at the 75-yard markers. A shallow bunker protects the left side of the green.
